# OPEN SCHOOLING RELEASE TO BE COMPLETED FOR EVERY RIDER

School in groups or in association with a group. No one should school alone and it is advisable that each group have someone on the ground with a working cell phone to aid in emergencies. Dial ' 911 ' and be prepared to give directions to Pine Hill. Check each obstacle before you school over it to make sure each is clear of hazards such as fallen branches. Don't jump any obstacle that is not flagged. Many obstacles can be jumped in both directions so make sure that no one is coming from the other direction. Take special care when schooling multiple obstacles. Unless conditions warrant, don't school at speed over multiple obstacles. Report any and all mishaps to Phil or Ruth.

All riders under the age of 21 MUST school under the supervision of a qualified adult instructor. If the minor rider's parent or guardian does not sign the accompanying release, the adult instructor must do so. *ANYONE* mounted is required to wear a helmet with attached chin strap and boots with heels.
